Candidates should have at least the equivalent of one academic year of postdoctoral experience abroad (outside the country of PhD-studies). Experience of the institutional aspects of development cooperation will be an asset. Active involvement in research centres or networks in developing countries (universities, NGOs or farmers' organisations) will be also appreciated.

He or she will have spent a considerable of his/her career on this topic and will have proven fund-raising capacity to finance studies. The supervision of Master and PhD students will be an integral part of this lectureship. He/she is expected to build an independent research team.

She or he will be expected to prove the capacity and the appetite for teaching university courses at Bachelor's and Master's level.

He or she is required to master the French language or to show the commitment to learn French during the third academic year and teach in French from then.

1. > Description of Position:

We are looking for an expert in agroecology with proven experience in development cooperation. Examples of areas of expertise are plant or animal production, agroforestry, agropastoralism, plant breeding and propagation, agricultural socio-economics and policies. At ULB, research and teaching will focus on the study and optimisation of tropical agroecosystems with particular emphasis on the integration of ecological and socio-economic dimensions at different time scales and spatial levels (from the plant level to different nested systemic levels).

➤ Courses:

- "Introduction to tropical agroecology": 5 ECTS (theory 36h, exercises: 12h, assignments: 12h)
- "Research and Development in agroecology": 3 ECTS (theory: 24h, exercises: 12h)

The first course is compulsory in the first year of our Masters in Agricultural Sciences and Environmental Sciences and Technologies; the second is compulsory in the second year of our Masters in Agricultural Sciences

> Description of Scientific and Pedagogical Objectives:

The successful applicant will be required to both run courses on tropical agroecology and develop research projects on this topic. We explicitly look for transdisciplinary approaches linking agroecological and socio-economic processes. More in particular, the research activities linked to this lectureship should aim for collaborations between our Interfaculty School of Bio-engineering (farming and agroforestry systems, biological control, spatial ecology) and the different fields of human sciences both present at the ULB (rural economy, anthropology, sociology, law, amongst others) and involved in natural resource management.

The newly appointed lecturer is required to fulfil her/his teaching duties in full, including the necessary research to feed the course material and the necessary administrative management duties of the university.
